

## Quadrant Graphs

These quadrant graphs can be given to a student before and after a lesson. The student marks their comprehension level prior to a lesson and again after a lesson. Tracking with these graphs can be a practical tool for seeing how the student feels about their mastery on a subject. It allows the facilitator to pull small groups for further instruction, know to spend more time on a subject, or progress on to the next level.



These graphs can also be used for social emotional learning as well by tracking social emotional goals over the course of the year.


